Leapfrog have described the **Food Stories Toolbox** as 'Flexible ways to capture and tell stories about food and food poverty'.

The Tools for Food Stories toolbox was co-designed by individuals with lived experience and food activists working with Leapfrog, a research project based at Lancaster University. The tools provide flexible ways of capturing and telling stories about food and food poverty.

The tools are available for free from www.leapfrog.tools and license with Creative Commons so anyone can edit and adapt the tools for their own needs.

The Toolbox is included in the SFP Toolkit as an extremely valuable resource that partnerships should consider using when engaging with people around issues related to food. The tools are geared towards exploring peoples' experiences of food poverty, but the processes and tools could be adapted for use to explore other food-related topics and issues.

The tools were developed in partnership with Sustain's **Food Power** programme and were particularly useful in bringing together groups of people who shared similar experiences of food poverty. The tools helped to identify groups and individuals in different communities around the UK who have been able to contribute to dialogue on food access and have contributed directly to the development of strategies and projects to address the issues.
